

Pre-Nursing Curriculum for LPNs

(Note: Students must complete 60 semester hours of designated courses to be considered for the BSN program. It is recommended that students complete **all** the pre-nursing courses including the general education requirements before beginning the nursing program. Refer to the Newman University catalog for a complete list of courses which meet the general education requirements.) Nursing faculty will assist in developing a plan of study to complete the pre-nursing curriculum.

*Courses that *MUST* be completed before beginning the nursing program.

+Grade must be a "C" or higher for consideration of acceptance to the BSN program.

Students may have no more than 6-12 hours of general education requirements remaining when starting the nursing sequence.

Baccalaureate Degree General Requirements

A total of 124 credit hours, including 40 credit hours of upper division courses (minimum) and 30 credit hours completed at Newman University (minimum). You must have a cumulative grade point average of 2.0 or higher.
