BUSINESS STUDIES major (B.S.)

Before students may enroll in the Business Studies program the following requirements must be met:

1. Admission to Newman University
2. Completion of a minimum of 62 semester credit hours including College Writing 1, College Writing 2, and Speech
3. Three years of full-time work experience
4. Acceptance to the Business Studies Program

*A student may be conditionally admitted into the Business Studies program without these courses. Conditionally admitted students must successfully complete these courses to satisfy the Business Studies major requirements for graduation. - a. Take the course
- b. Portfolio from the course
- c. Be familiar with Word, plus take Saturday Seminars in Access and Excel
