

Specific requirements for Master of Science In Education Degree

Admission Requirements

1. Completed application to the Masters in Education Program
2. Evidence of teaching certification (except for Concentration in Curriculum and Instruction, emphasis in Accountability)
3. A writing sample of 300 to 500 words on an assigned topic
4. Verification of three years full-time teaching experience (required only for Concentration in Building Leadership)
5. Two letters of recommendation. (For concentration in Building Leadership, at least one of those letters should come from the school principal or superintendent; for all other concentrations, letters should come from supervisors, co-workers, or previous instructors.)
6. Grade point average of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale for undergraduate or previous graduate study. Students who do not meet the GPA requirement are required to submit GRE exam scores or MAT scores by the end of their first semester of graduate study.
