**Semester Tuition:** The flat rate tuition for 12-19 credit hours is \$9600, or from 1-11 credit hours, the rate is \$640 per credit hour. Tuition and fees are subject to change without notice.

**Textbooks:** Textbooks may be purchased in the Newman University Bookstore located in Dugan Library.

**Nursing Kit/Watch with Second Hand/Stethoscope with Bell and Diaphragm:** The nursing kit contains supplies for use in the nursing lab. A stethoscope with bell and diaphragm is required in the nursing lab and when giving patient care. A stethoscope may be purchased through NU for \$60. A watch with a second hand is required.

**Liability Insurance:** Liability insurance coverage is required of all nursing students. The annual premium for \$1,000,000 (one million dollars)/event and \$3,000,000 aggregate coverage is **\$16 (cash only)** in the exact amount. A group policy will be initiated.

**Name Tag:** The name tag is **\$3 (cash only)** in the exact amount. Pictures for student ID are taken in Dugan Library.

**Student Uniform:** The Newman University nursing student uniform consists of a royal blue scrub top with the NU emblem, white lab jacket, and galaxy blue pants. Uniforms are to be purchased from the Newman Bookstore.

**ATI Fee:** The ATI fee is \$137.75 for the 1st semester and \$117.75 each semester afterwards. The fee will be added to tuition and is payable in Student Accounts.

**TB Screening:** It is required that all students be screened for tuberculosis every year and documentation is to be given to the Nursing Office.

**CPR Certification:** This certification must be a **Healthcare Provider or Professional Rescuer course with Adult, Child and Infant CPR and Foreign Body Airway Obstruction**, current in the year of admission to the program and updated as needed.

**NCLEX Application Fee:** The NCLEX-RN application is completed with a credit card on-line. Detailed information will be supplied at the beginning of fourth semester.

**KSBN Application Fee:** The KSBN application fee is sent with the student application for licensure. The KSBN will accept a money order, cashier's check or personal check. Detailed information will be supplied at the beginning of fourth semester.

**Transcript Fee:** The KSBN requires an official transcript upon graduation and is sent from the Nursing Office. Transcript fee is \$5 per transcript. If a transcript is required by an employer, an additional transcript may be requested and purchased in the Registrar's Office.

**Nursing Pin:** The nursing pin is optional and cost depends on the price of silver or gold at the time of order. The pin is awarded during the pinning/recognition ceremony which is held before Baccalaureate.

**Graduation Fee:** NU charges a \$75 graduation fee which is payable in the Registrar's Office accompanied with the graduation application. Graduation applications must be signed by the nursing faculty advisor.

**Picture for KSBN Application:** The KSBN requires a professionally taken picture attached to the

student application for licensure. A passport photo is obtained meeting the KSBN criteria. This picture must reflect professional dress. Detailed information will be supplied at the beginning of fourth semester.

**Nursing Club Fee (Optional):** The Nursing Club is open to any student who has declared nursing as a major (including pre-nursing). The club meets approximately four times a semester over the noon hour. The fee is \$10 per semester. Detailed information will be supplied at the beginning of first semester.
